Photos must highlight the area of work to be judged and reflect and address the judging criteria being used. Photos may be displayed at the Awards Banquet. Note: On restoration or poured concrete projects it is recommended that before and/or in-progress photos are submitted.

DESCRIPTION: A detailed project description must be submitted which describes the area to be judged and the features of excellence for judges' consideration (i.e. aesthetic value, unique structural/mechanical features or highlights, hurdles faced in project, innovation of project). Be sure to include specifics of the project such as type of materials used, square footage, and materials suppliers. **NOTE: The best project descriptions often result in higher judges' scores. There is ample room in this online field for a full description.**
